# AutoCRC Student Project Program

AutoCRC has established a program with eight universities to find opportunities for final year students to become involved in projects within the automotive industry.

AutoCRC will share the costs of sponsoring a student to work with your company for around 200hrs. If you can provide an interesting and practical research topic, 50hrs of your time and \$2,500 sponsorship, you could have a student or a team of students applying their skills, knowledge, creativity and talent towards your goals.

Other reasons to take up this opportunity include the chance to:

- ◆ assess what current graduates are capable of
- ◆ gain a new source of ideas
- ◆ follow up ideas that you otherwise would have left on the shelf
- ◆ develop your ability to work with a younger generation
